DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in December 2019, a novel strain of the coronavirus was detected which causes coronavirus disease, or COVID-19, and it has spread globally into a pandemic with confirmed cases in all 50 states and, as of this declaration, with two confirmed cases in Columbia County; and

WHEREAS, international organizations, the federal government, the state government, the county and other local units of government are all working together to contain the further spread of COVID-19; and


WHEREAS, the World Health Organization has declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern, the United States Department of Health and Human Services has declared a Public Health Emergency, and the State of Wisconsin has declared a Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the health and well being of our City residents, we must all avail ourselves to all the resources needed to respond to and contain the presence of COVID-19 in our community; and

NOW, THEREFORE, as the City of Lodi Mayor, Columbia County, Wisconsin, I hereby declare the following:

- A public health emergency exists in the City of Lodi until such time that the City Common Council votes to repeal the declaration or the State of Wisconsin Public Health Emergency is no longer in effect.
- Urge all City residents to comply with the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) Mitigation Strategies for Communities with Local COVID-19 Transmission dated March 12, 2020, found at www.cdc.gov/COVID19.
- Urge all City residents to practice social distancing to the maximum extent they are able to do so.
