1.) Call to Order

3.) Approval of the Minutes from the May 15th, 2019 Meeting:

Smith is also a board member for the Wisconsin Association of Homicide Investigations. Smith's vision while serving as the Interim Lodi Police Chief is to increase staff training, provide equipment and resources, add additional programs to increase efficiency and create a working environment to encourage employee retention and growth of the department.
