### Corridor Plan Steering Committee Meeting Minutes of April 16, 2019

**1. Call to Order.**

Chair Tonn called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

**2. Public Input.** None

**3. Minutes of the February 26, 2019 Meeting.** MOTION (Stevenson, West) to approve the minutes of the 2/26/2019 meeting. Motion carried.

**4. Points of Interest Signage.** Ostrander handed out two quotes received for signage – one quote from Decker and a second from DEW. Buhr reviewed the discussion that took place with Decker. Further discussion took place about the size and design of signs – standard vs. custom and it was agreed the smaller of the two options, 27 x 36, and the custom cut was preferred for the City. Discussion arose about the quantity of signs and where to locate them. It was noted that, because the 4-way stop is state highway, it may be limited where signs can be placed due to the congestion of many signs. Buhr mentioned that we may want to consider placing signs in a location that helps divert traffic from the 4-way stop, providing an alternate route to points of interest. It was also brought up that smaller single points of interest signage may be placed appropriately near the point of interest. This signage was not included in the quotes. No further direction or recommendation was made and this item was referred to continue at Public Works & Utilities Committee.

**5. Refer Items of Committee.** Tonn suggested a review of the items that have been discussed by the committee to refer to other appropriate committees.

*City Crosswalks* – previously referred to continue at Public Works & Utilities Committee; although discussion was raised about the paint color with no recommendation

*Streetscaping Street Light Poles/Fixtures* – referred to Public Works & Utilities Committee

*Ice Age Trail Community* – discussion about it being promoted within the City; referred as a standing item on Economic Development Committee

*Doctor's Park* – discussion of this potential development of the Park; referred to Parks Committee with reference to the Capstone Spring Creek Walkway

*Spring Creek Walkway* – concept including ADA compliance ramp to be referred to EDC and, at the appropriate time, also Public Works & Utilities Committee

*Downtown Parking* – accessibility and relief effort for downtown parking, perhaps a concept to be brought to downtown property owners; referred to Economic Development Committee

*Street Reconfiguration* – when appropriate with Hwy 113/60 changes, consider modification; referred to Public Works & Utilities Committee

*Design Guidelines for Corridor* – discussed generally to refer to Plan Commission

*Trees along Corridor* – smaller size trees to be planted along the Corridor; referred to Public Works & Utilities Committee

6. **Ice Age Trail Community.** Welch distributed the Ice Age Trail annual report highlighting the total volunteer hours. Additionally, he distributed the pamphlet for Art on the Trail. The event's opening reception is May 3rd. Additionally, he reported that the Lodi Valley Chapter will be the feature article this week Sunday 4/21.
