**6. Discussion and Possible Recommendation Regarding Agreement with Pickleball Club**

Goethel questioned if the Pickleball Club has insurance coverage. Staff needs to check with legal regarding insurance so that future MOUs are treated the same.

**7. Discussion and Possible Recommendation Regarding MSA Task Order for Spring Creek Bridge**

Zimmer explained the attached Task Order. Originally planned on 2022 completion but has been moved to 2023 and the grant is a 2-year grant so 2023 date qualifies. Additional Services were discussed and the city would have to request the additional services before they would be completed. Bilkey wanted to state that the city will probably end up spending more than documented. Klobberdanz wanted to verify that flooding events are taken into consideration and the low girder for items like kayaks or canoes should clear.

Goethel suggests that everyone takes a step back and look at the CORP plan. Request Weter to bring back an estimate on the cost to level and seed.
