

Lodi School Resource Office Roles and responsibilities

The officer's hours during the school year would normally be during school hours and include school events outside of normal school hours.

Responsibilities could include.

- School presence at all Lodi Schools
- Presence at school related functions
 - Sporting events
 - School board meetings
 - Protests / demonstrations
 - Other special events (dances, presentations gatherings etc.)
- Respond to emergencies at schools
- Address incidents at the schools that rise to the level of ordinance / criminal violations
 - Thefts
 - Criminal damage to property
 - Vehicle related (parking, accidents)
 - Truancy
 - Disorderly conduct
 - Possession of tobacco / vaping
 - Possession of drugs /paraphernalia
 - Underage alcohol violations
 - Computer / Internet crimes (Threats) (distributing pornographic material)
 - Assaults (Physical / sexual)
- Consult with school admin on incidents that do not rise to the level of LE action
- Participate in education/ prevention programs and activities.
