

City of Lodi Public Safety Committee Meeting
Minutes of October 1st, 2024

1. Call to Order

Chair Hansen called the meeting to order at 4:00pm.

4. Approval of Minutes from September 3rd, 2024

MOTION (Heller/Hansen) to approve the minutes from the September 3rd meeting. No discussion. Roll call vote- All ayes. **Motion carried.**

5. Discussion Regarding Requests for Stop Signs at Intersection of Sauk St. & Fieldstone Dr.

Smith advised Police Department (PD) staff provided extra patrol in this area since last meeting. PD hasn't seen significant speeding at this location. Discussion occurred on congestion increase before and after school if stop sign put in at this location. Pedestrian flashing signage set to be installed and there is a crossing guard in the afternoon at this intersection. PD hasn't received any additional complaints about this intersection. While stop signage not out of question, current committee consensus is to allow PD to monitor and provide updates to Public Safety during Chief's report. Chief Smith did advise if stop signage were to be placed in this area, he would ask for illuminated pedestrian signage to be moved to Dale Dr. where no traffic control is provided.

6. Police Department Monthly Report

Financials reviewed- Smith reported on expenditure line item, contracted services, to pay for consultant study. Ayers noted this line item also covered \$4100 for crossing guards. Garage electric use increased and Smith trying to track down potential cause. 673 calls during month of September, averaging 22.5 per day. There is an uptick in juvenile related calls for service with school back in session. Citation numbers down, likely due to staffing.

7. EMS Monthly Report

Groves-Lloyd provided update on EMS Commission meeting. IGA standing item on agenda, once fire IGA written, EMS IGA will be looked at. Chief's report and financials reviewed. Groves-Lloyd, as commission member, recommended audit of books and will come back to EMS in October with proposal.
